WHAT'S NEW IN MINDMANAGER READER FOR SHAREPOINT

- MindManager Server App for SharePoint has been renamed to MindManager Reader for SharePoint.
- MindManager Reader for SharePoint WSP version is a Solution for SharePoint that provides MindManager icons for Maps in SharePoint document libraries on classic SharePoint sites and adds map specific menu options (View in Browser/Open in MindManager) to the SharePoint document library context menu (ellipsis menu) on classic and modern SharePoint sites.
- MindManager Reader for SharePoint provides improved Map Rendering and Support for the Latest MindManager Features.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

As a Site Collection Administrator,

download the WSP Zip file from the MindManager Reader for SharePoint section on the MindManager Enterprise Download page and extract it to your hard drive

In SharePoint, go to top level site settings and select “Solutions” in the Web Designer Galleries section

- If you have previously installed an earlier version of MindManager Reader for SharePoint, look for “MindManagerSP2013” in the Solutions library and deactivate the solution.
- Click on “Upload Solution” and make sure “Overwrite existing files” is checked in the “Add a document” dialog
- Upload the file “MindManagerSP2013.wsp” from the extracted zip file to the Solutions library
- Activate the solution
- **Note:** “Microsoft SharePoint Foundation Sandboxed Code Service” is required to be enabled on the SharePoint server to activate the solution
 - “Central Administration > System Settings > Manage Services on Server > Microsoft SharePoint Foundation Sandboxed Code Service > Start “
(requires SharePoint Administrator rights)

USING MINDMANAGER READER

Viewing Maps in the Browser

- Click on the Map or MindManager Deck name in a document library (requires the SharePoint Classic Experience view to be enabled). OR
- Use the file context menu (ellipsis menu) and choose ‘View in Browser’.
- Use the Browser ‘Back’ button to exit viewing a map and return to SharePoint.

Opening Maps in MindManager

(Requires MindManager 2017 and later for Windows to be installed)

- In SharePoint, use the file context menu and choose ‘Open in MindManager’.
- You can also open a Map with your installed MindManager for Windows desktop application by clicking the “Menu” button in the MindManager Reader windows and selecting “Open in MindManager”.
